Nesting Bowls Crochet Pattern



This is a great little set of nesting bowls for holding odds and ends on your desk, filling with shells , stones, etc. as decoration.....they can be used to hold most anything. The bowls pictured are made from Bare Sheep Yarn Company's New Zealand worsted weight wool. There are three bowls ranging from 6" in diameter to 3 3/4" in diameter and 2" deep. The diameter of the bowl will greatly depend on your blocking.

You will need:

- *6 oz. total of worsted weight yarn (approx. 4 oz. of color A and 2 oz. of color B)
- *removable beginning round marker
- *size D crochet hook
- *row counter

Stitches:

ch–chain

sc–single crochet

dc–double crochet

hdc– half double crochet

***Note: always slip stitch at the end of each round

1. Chain 4 and slip stitch in beginning chain to form a loop
2. Ch 1, sc 6 inside loop, sl closing loop
3. Ch 1, sc in 1st chain, 2 sc in every chain to end
4. Ch 1, *sc in 1st chain, 2 sc in 2nd chain* repeat from * to * to end of round
5. Ch 1, sc in 1st chain, 2 sc in 2nd chain, *sc in next two chains, 2sc in next chain* repeat from * to * to end of round
6. Ch 1, sc in 1st chain, 2 sc in 2nd chain, *sc in next 3 chains, 2 sc in next chain* repeat from * to * to end of round
7. Ch 1, sc in 1st chain, 2 sc in 2nd chain, *sc in next 4 chains, 2 sc in next chain* repeat from * to * to end of round
(NOTE: For small bowl jump to # 11)
8. Ch 1, sc in every chain to end of round
9. Ch 1, sc in 1st chain, 2 sc in 2nd chain, *sc in next 5 chains, 2 sc in next chain* repeat from * to * to end of round
(NOTE: For medium bowl jump to #11)
10. Ch 1, sc in 1st chain, 2 sc in 2nd chain *sc in next 6 chains, 2 sc in next chain* repeat from * to * to end of round
11. Ch 1, sc in all chains
12. Ch 1, sc in all chains
13. Ch 1, sc in 1st chain, sc in next {5 for small, 6 for medium, 7 for large}
2sc in next chain, sc {6 for small, 7 for medium, 8 for large} repeat from * to * to end of round
14. Ch 1, sc {4 rounds for small, 5 rounds for medium, 6 rounds for large}

Switch colors if desired for rim

Fan Trim

1. Ch 1, sc to end
2. Ch 1, sc in 2nd chain from hook *ch 3, skip 5 chains, work 1 dc into 4th chain of previous 5th chain just skipped {work from behind}, chain 3, skip 3 chains, 1 sc in next chain* repeat from * to * to end of round
3. Ch 4, skip 1st ch, *skip next 3 ch space, work 1 dc into 5 chain arch, skip next 3 ch space, work 1 hdc in next chain space* repeat from * to * to end of round
4. Slip stitch and weave in loose ends

Felt and block.
